


# ZENITH

## Description

Zenith is a vertically driven architectural screen defined by a gradient of finely spaced linear apertures that shift in density across the panel. The pattern creates a subtle fading effect that naturally draws the eye upward, reinforcing height and vertical emphasis. Its disciplined geometry delivers a contemporary, architectural presence that balances privacy with openness, making it ideal for spaces that require clarity and structure without visual heaviness.



## Performance & Selection Criteria

- **Openness:** 25%
- **Visual Screening:** 85 / 100
- **Pattern Scale:** 70 / 100
- **Rotation Tolerance:** 20 / 100
- **Structural Fragmentation Risk:** 30 / 100
- **Sightline Interruption:** High
- **Shade Factor:** 65%

- **Backlighting Compatibility:** Very good – optimized for side-grazing or top-down lighting that accentuates vertical depth and shadow
